The course will focus on laying a strong foundation for the process of further language comprehension and articulation needed at various developmental stages. Emphasis will be placed on identifiers of persons and things in one's immediate environments, along with engaging others in questions or response to questions.

## **Course Learning Outcomes:**

Upon completion of this course, learners will be able to demonstrate foundational knowledge and competencies of the following:

1. An understanding of pronunciations.
2. An understanding of social references in relation to self, others, numbers, space and time.
3. An understanding of expressions as it relates to communicating feelings and thoughts.
4. An understanding of appropriate use of accord as it relates to the young, peers, seniority and eldership throughout socio-interactions.
5. A basic understanding of what things are as it relates to materials.
